

S., ex-wife of Daniel Ambash, before becoming State Witness for the Prosecution

Greetings to all,

I am S.XXX, ID. XXXXX, I'm writing to you because I have lost all hopes !

I said, under police's threats, things that helped them arrest my husband Daniel Ambash on the 4/7/11. He still is under arrest, charged with vey heavy charges.

On purpose, they forced out of my mouth words against him, they locked me in difficult conditions, they threatened me : if I didn't talk, they wouldn't let me see my 6-years-old daughter. And they added : you better say what we want you to say.

Of course I'm afraid, till today, to admit I spoke during the investigations but it was under heavy threats. My conscience doesn't let me quiet anymore.

I admit it and published it online : I just wanted to say freely the truth. But then, the police threatened me again, telling me the social workers who keep my daughter won't let me see her because of what I published online. They will not let me see her neither my family for Rosh Hashana (*jewish New Year*).

I'm asking you, is it my punishment or my daughter's punishment ? I'm asking you, is there such a law in our country that forbids to tell the truth ?

And if you do want to say the truth, you should be punished ! After all my daughter will never be able to forget this punishment and, in the future, she's going to suffer more and more from the inhuman acts witch were done against her father, against me and against her !

She will also not understand how I could testify against her father the way I did !

It is even more difficult to understand because of the vulgar language of the indictment.

Someone transcribed it as if it was my language. But because of the way the guilt and the testimonies are written, I suppose the people who wrote it must be the police officers who arrested the family.
